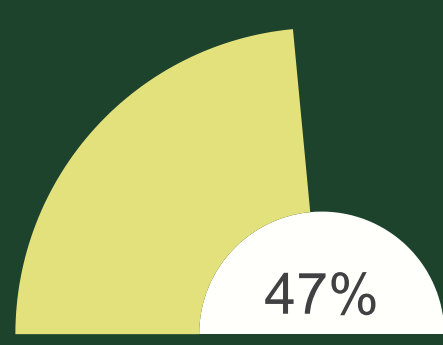

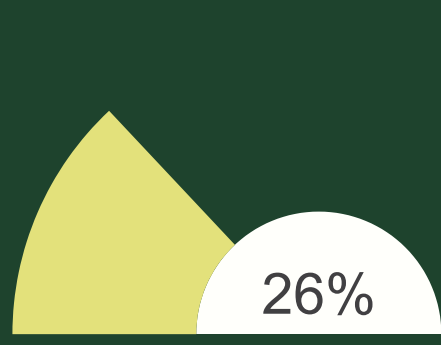

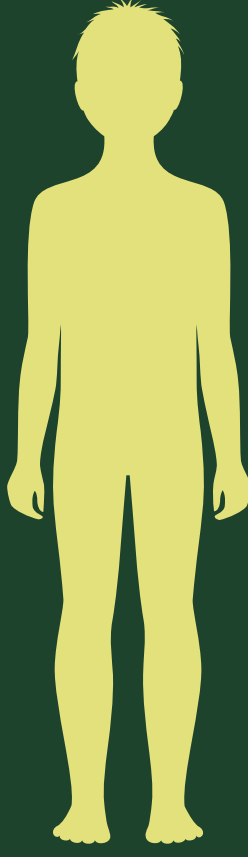
48% OF STUDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR FREE OR REDUCED LUNCH

12% OF MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS HAVE TRIED TO KILL THEMSELVES

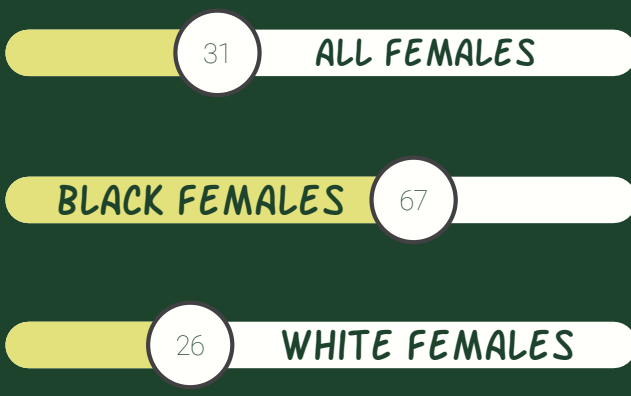


47% OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS REPORT TRYING TO LOSE WEIGHT

TEEN BIRTHS PER 1,000 FEMALES AGES 15-19



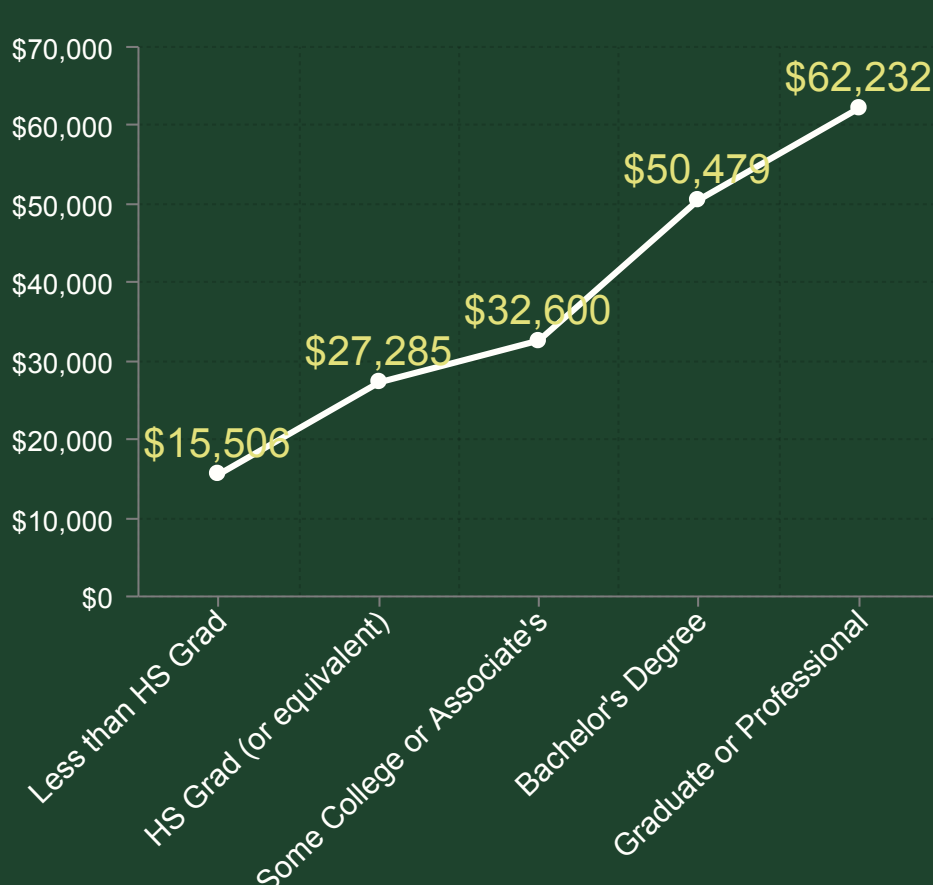

EXPECTED EARNINGS BY ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

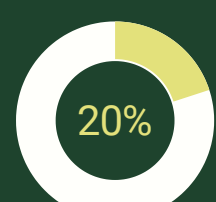


MEDIAN EARNINGS

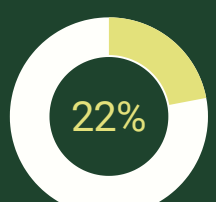


PERCENT OF POPULATION WITH BACHELOR'S DEGREE OR HIGHER

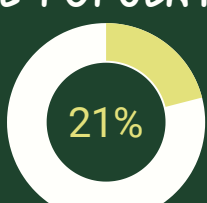
BLACK FEMALES



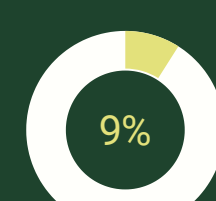
WHITE FEMALES



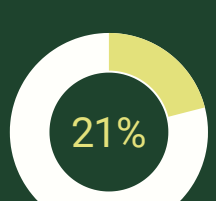
WHOLE POPULATION
