Trusted Advisor Update

- Provided the Trusted Advisor data report update.
- Received two \$60,000 grants for the Trusted Advisors.
- The Great Start Collaborative Executive Committee has provided funding that will have the Trusted Advisors working through the end of the year.
- Working on reaching out to local service providers to provide them feedback on how the community views their services.
- Applied to the Community Foundation and were approved for a full proposal.

Clinical Community Linkages Flyer

- Provided a fact sheet on the HUB (the Clinical and Community Linkages strategy)
- All the agencies are connected through a referral system.
- Allows agencies to follow up with the person.
- The Trusted Advisors aren't in the HUB as a service provider.

Planning conversation for new year

- Group reviewed system scan data to find additional areas of focus.
- Brought up cost of preschool, benefits of preschool, programs that are available, and parenting skills for challenging behaviors

- Priority should be on getting information out
- Parent mentoring program
- WIC and immunization clinics to have preschool information
