#### Clinical Community Linages Project – Josh Williams

- SIM is the state innovation model.
- Jackson has many activities around the community.
- Screening for social determinants is required.
- Linkages were created between the clinical side and services in the community.
- Once a resource is identified the community agency is sent the information, and the original screener is receiving real time feedback.
- System is also able to send notes with the person's chart.
- Client agrees to have their information sent to the various agencies.
- A change in HIPAA privacy rules allows for this contact for coordinated care.
- 10 standard questions include "Do you need help with child care or preschool?"
- The agency has 72 hours to connect with the person.
- The Clinical Community Linkages Group will be able to pull aggregate data on gaps in the community.

#### Non-Traditional Child Care Update/Needs

- Working with TAC and Great Lakes to distribute a flyer.
- Created a list of child care providers within 15 miles.
