### **Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)**

- Free preschool program funded by the state of Michigan for 4 year olds
- Children of all abilities can participate
- Teachers are certified in Early Childhood Education
- 2 or 3 teachers for every 15-18 students
- Research based curriculum that includes health, safety, literacy and social development
- Offers a mix of full and part day programs
- Childcare to extend the day is available at some locations
- Transportation is available for some locations
- Meals and snacks are provided depending on the length of the program
- Parent involvement is encouraged and supported through classroom volunteering, parent meetings and activities
